#### REGISTRATION

Registration for admission can be done in advance by remitting Rs.100/- (Non refundable) at the School Office.

#### **ADMISSION**

On the date of admission, admission fee and the first instalment of tuition fee should be remitted. The fee once remitted will not be refunded under any circumstance.

#### **PAYMENT OF FEES**

The fee shall be paid in 4 instalments, in April/May, August, November and January.

#### **DATE OF PAYMENT**

I Instalment : On or before issuing text books

II Instalment : Before August 10th - Without fine

III Instalment: Before November 10th - Without fine

IV Instalment : Before January 10th - Without fine

Bus fee should be paid on or before the 10th day of every month.

The receipts of the fees remitted should be kept. Duplicates of the same will not be issued.

#### **EXAMINATION AND PROMOTION**

The School strictly follows the CBSE pattern of examination. Promotion of a pupil will be based on his/her performance in examinations. Absence or exemption from any subject in the examination will not be permitted under any circumstance. Students should maintain perfect order and discipline during the examination. Any malpractice discovered during or after the examination will seriously be dealt with.

#### **OPEN HOUSE**

Parents are requested to meet the teachers concerned after each examination for a regular feed back of their wards' overall developments and progress. Assessment records of examinations will be issued only to the parents during the open house.

#### INSTRUCTIONS TO BE OBSERVED BY THE STUDENTS

- 1. Students Should obey, love and respect all teachers. They should abide by the rules and regulations of the school.
- 2. It is imperative to speak in English in the school campus and school bus. Frequent defaulters will be fined appropriately.
- 3. Students are not permitted to leave the school premises during school hours.
- 4. Smoking and use of intoxicants are strictly forbidden. Violators will summarily be expelled from the school.
- 5. It will be the responsibility of the students to safeguard their personal belongings.
- 6. Valuables like gold ornamets are strictly forbidden. Electronic gadgets like mobilephones, pendrives, laptops, bluetooth, camera and articles like comic books, fancy items, toys, sweets, chewingum etc. should not be bought to school.

- 7. Students should make it point to study the lessons taught at school each day and to do the home work given by the teacher.
- 8. Late coming and irregularities regarding uniform will severely be dealt with. Regulation regarding school uniform should strictly be adhered to.
- 9. All Students should cultivate the habit of reading news papers, periodicals and other good books. They should prepare brief notes also.
- 10. Behaviour of the students both inside and outside the school premises, will carefully be observed. Misdemeanour will not be forgiven.
- 11. Students inflicted with infectious diseases shall be allowed to attend classes only after they are completely cured.
- 12. Nail growing and polishing should not be allowed. Proper decent hair grooming and shaving are positively expected.
- 13. Fancy ornaments and unnecessary hair accessories have to be avoid.
- 14. Uniforms should be properly stitched. Students are expected to wear decently and properly stitched uniforms associating completely with the uniform pattern introduced by the school.
- 15. Students should not destroy, damage or deface the school property.
- 16. Any damage or loss of the school property or that of other students should be made good by the students concerned.

#### INSTRUCTIONS TO PARENTS

- 1. Check the diary daily and ensure that it is sent to school everyday.
- 2. Any change in your address or telephone number should be intimated to the school promptly.
- 3. Label all belongings of your ward.

- 4. Send napkin everyday with the lunch and snacks.
- 5. Make sure whether your ward needs special attention on any subject which he/she feels difficult.
- 6. Send the children in clean complete uniform with all required books and ensure that they are punctual.
- 7. Students inflicted with infectious diseases shall be allowed to attend classes only after they are completely cured.
- 8. Make sure that comic books, fancy articles, electronic gadgets like mobile phone, pendrive, camera, laptop etc. are not brought to school.
- 9. Go through the school diary daily and assess the performance of the children and also make sure that children devote enough time for studies at home.
- 10. Use suggestion box by lodging your valuable suggestions and observations.
- 11. Acknowledge receipts of all notes / circulars and communications received through the school diary.
- 12. Parents or others are not allowed to meet the students during class hours. In emergency permissions for the same should be obtained from the Manager / Administrator/Principal.
- 13. Parents are requested not to take the children away from the school during class hours but in exigency.
- 14. Each student is responsible for the safe keeping of his / her own belongings. The school will not be responsible for any loss.
- 15. The Management of the school pays keen attention to the health, security and well being of the students. The Management however shall not be responsible in any way for any illness, injury, mishap or accident of any student.
- 16. Parents are expected to be present in all common

- celebrations. Parents are requested to come to the school occasionally to discuss their wards' standard, performance and progress with the Teachers, Principal, Administrator and Manager.
- 17. Parents / guardians are always welcome to the school to check up on their children's progress. Separate days are allotted for parent-teacher meetings of various classes.
- 18. The Management may require a parent / guardian to withdraw his / her child in case he/she does not obey the rules and regulations of the school. In such cases the decisions of the Management shall be final.
- 19. If parents have any complaint against the members of the staff they are requested to meet the Man ager/Administrator for redressal
- 20. The school Management expects parents' whole hearted co-operation and support. The parents are requested to comply with the rules and regulations of the school.
- 21. The school Management thinks that mobile phones, ipod etc. can play havoc with students, though these are a boon to present life. The students of SESPS are strictly advised not to bring these in school premises. The violators will be expelled from the school forthwith

#### **OBJECTIVE**

The core and strong aim of the school is to provide full-liberal and comprehensive education so as to develop in the child a sound character and a fine personality. The objective is to produce women and men with a keen sense of discipline, responsibility, initiative, dedication, integrity and loyalty. In fact it is an all round drawing out of the best in the child from her/his body, mind and soul.

The motto of the school is "Wisdom Moulds Life"

#### PARENT - TEACHER ASSOCIATION (P.T.A.)

The school expects the hearty and full fledged cooperation of all parents and wellwishers for the smooth and progressive functioning of the school. The PTA has been constituted comprising representatives of parents and teachers. The Chairman of the school shall be the President, Manager Working President, Administrator Co-ordinator, all the members of the Governing Body ex-officio members and the Principal Secretary. A Vice President will be nominated from the parent representatives by the chairman of the school

#### **ATTENDENCE**

- 1. Parents should see that their wards do not remain absent, except under unavoidable circumstances, as it badly affects the progress of the wards.
- 2. The pupils should be in the school premises before first bell. Late arrival will be penalized.
- 3. If the pupil is absent from school, application for leave must be submitted in advance.
- 4. In case of absence due to sickness or other emergencies, a leave letter must be sent to the school on the first day of absence. Leave on medical ground should be supported by a medical certificate.
- 5. No leave is granted on examination days, the first and last working days, without a valid reason. Written request for the same should be submitted to the Class Teacher/Principal
- 6. Irregular attendance and prolonged absence may lead to removal from school.
- 7. A minimum of 85 % attendance is a requirement for promotion to the higher class.
- 8. No pupil shall be allowed to leave the school premises during school time.

#### ASSESSMENT

The School will be conducting regular assessment so that the teachers as well as the parents can have an idea as to how much the pupil has been able to comprehend. This will help to monitor the general day-to-day progress of the pupil. Report on periodical assessment of the ward will be given to the parents at the end of each term.

#### STRUCTURE OF ASSESSMENT SCHEME

The Assessment scheme will have theory, internal assessment or practical components as per syllabus given for each subject. Board shall conduct Annual examinations for class XII

As the Board is progressively allowing more space to 'learning outcome based' assessment in place of textbook driven assessment, question papers of Board examinations will have more questions based on real-life situations requiring students to apply, analyse, evaluate and synthesize information as per the stipulated outcomes. The core-competencies to be assessed in all questions, however, will be from the prescribed syllabus and textbooks recommended therein. This will eliminate predictability and rote learning to a large extent.

#### **Annual examination:**

#### For Class XII

The Board Examination will cover the entire syllabus of Class-XII as per syllabus for each subject.

#### **Internal Assessment:**

Internal Assessment in different subjects will be as per details given in the syllabus for each subject.

#### STRUCTURE OF ASSESSMENT SCHEME

The Assessment scheme will have an 80 marks component for Board examination (class X) and Annual Examination (class

IX) in all subjects except compulsory subjects to be assessed internally along with a 20 marks component of Internal Assessment. Students have to secure 33 percent in total in each of these components.

# Board Examination for (Class X) and Annual Examination

The Board Examination in each subject will cover entire syllabus of Class-X. Grades corresponding to the marks shall be on the basis of 9-point grading system. Grades will be awarded in each scholastic subject. For awarding the grades, the Board will put all the passed students in a rank order and will award the grades

# **INTERNAL ASSESSMENT (20 marks):**

#### Periodic Tests (05 marks):

As earlier, these would be restricted to 3 in each subject in a year and the average of best 2 would to be taken for final submission of marks. These tests tend to follow a pattern, which is quite similar to the final end of course examination, and have a gradually increasing portion of content. Hence, they also tend to prepare students for final summative exams in a more confident manner.

# Multiple Assessment (05 marks):

Multiple assessment strategies relevant to particular learning outcomes are advised over the period of curriculum transaction. The subject teachers would determine the type and frequency of these. This would make assessment more comprehensive and provide schools/teachers flexibility to use multiple and diverse techniques to assess learners viz. observation, oral tests, individual or group work, class discussion, field-work, concept maps, graphic organizers, visual representation etc.

#### Portfolio (05 marks):

A portfolio is a collection of chosen work by a student representing a selection of performances that is collected over time and describes the learner's efforts, progress, and achievement in key areas. It is a tool for assessing a variety of skills not usually testable in a single setting of the traditional written paper and pencil tests.

### **Subject Enrichment Activities (05 marks):**

Subject enrichment activities aligned with the secondary school curriculum aim at enrichment of the understanding and skill development. They provide in-depth learning that motivates students to dig deeper into the discipline. These enrichment activities need to challenge students and permit them to apply knowledge to the next level. These activities become an important instrument to learn the processes by which knowledge is generated in a particular discipline.
